Activity: Creating "Ish" Art

Duration: Approximately 30–45 minutes

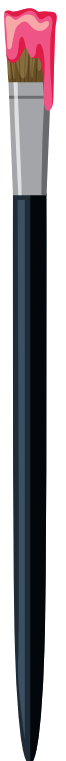
Materials Needed:

Copies of the book 'Ish' by Peter H. Reynolds

Drawing paper or sketchbooks

Crayons, markers, or watercolor paints

Optional: Inspirational objects from the book (e.g., stars, fish, boats, etc.)



Gather the preschoolers in a comfortable and quiet area.

Introduce the book 'Ish' by Peter H. Reynolds. Briefly summarize the story's main theme, where the character learns to embrace the idea of creating "ish" art, emphasizing that it's okay for things to be a little imperfect.

Encourage the children to draw their own "ish" versions of their favorite things or objects from the book. Remind them that it's okay if their sketches are not perfect. Encourage them to add their own creative touches, variations, and interpretations to the object to make it their own "ish" version.
