Set up a "love potion" station with baking soda, vinegar, and heart-shaped containers and cookie cutters. Let children mix and pour to witness the fizzy reactions, fostering curiosity and basic chemistry concepts.

Provide various colors of playdough and heart-shaped cookie cutters. Encourage imaginative play as children create their own Valentine's Day masterpieces.




#### **CUP HEART TOWER BUILDING: ENGINEERING LOVE!**
