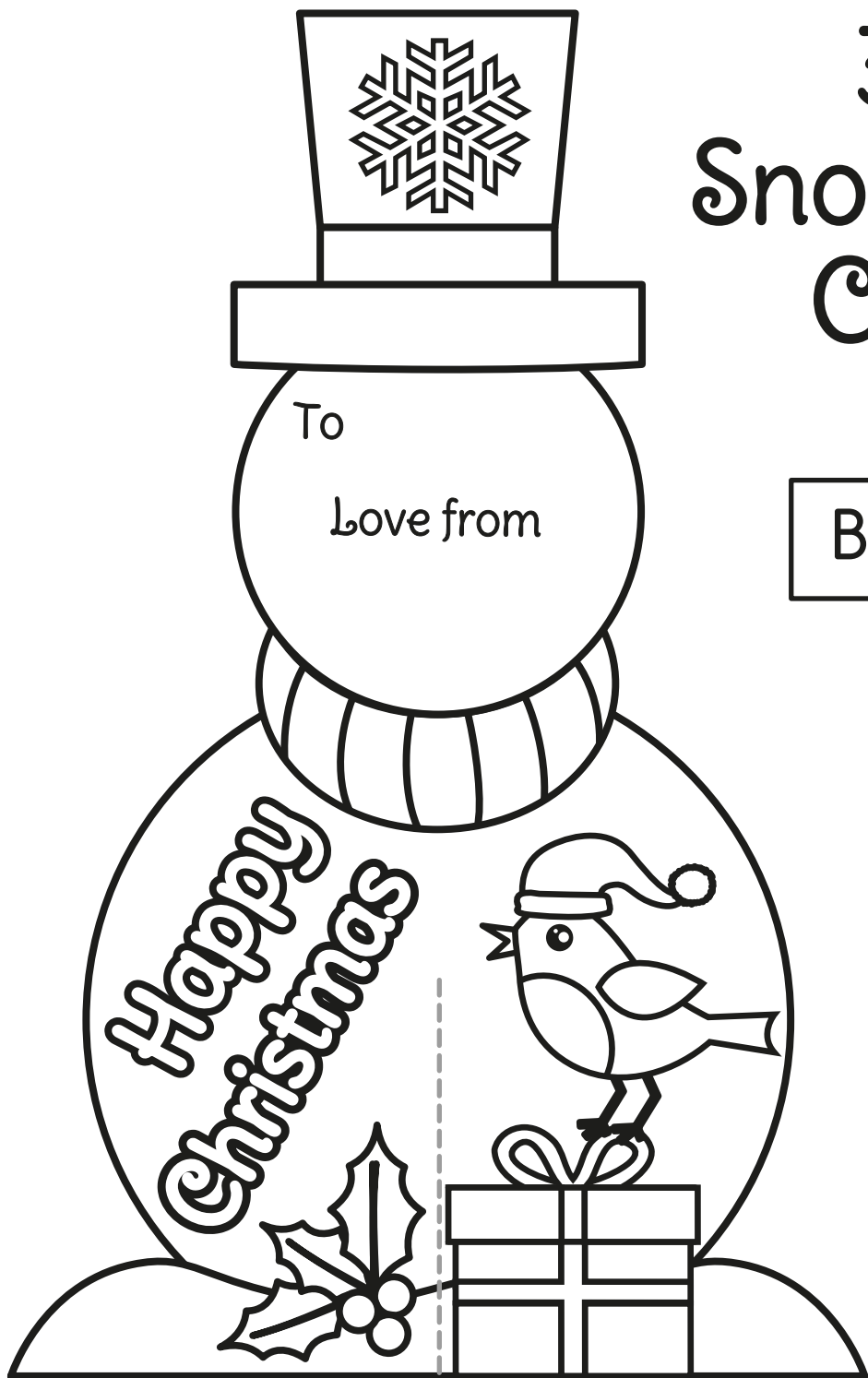
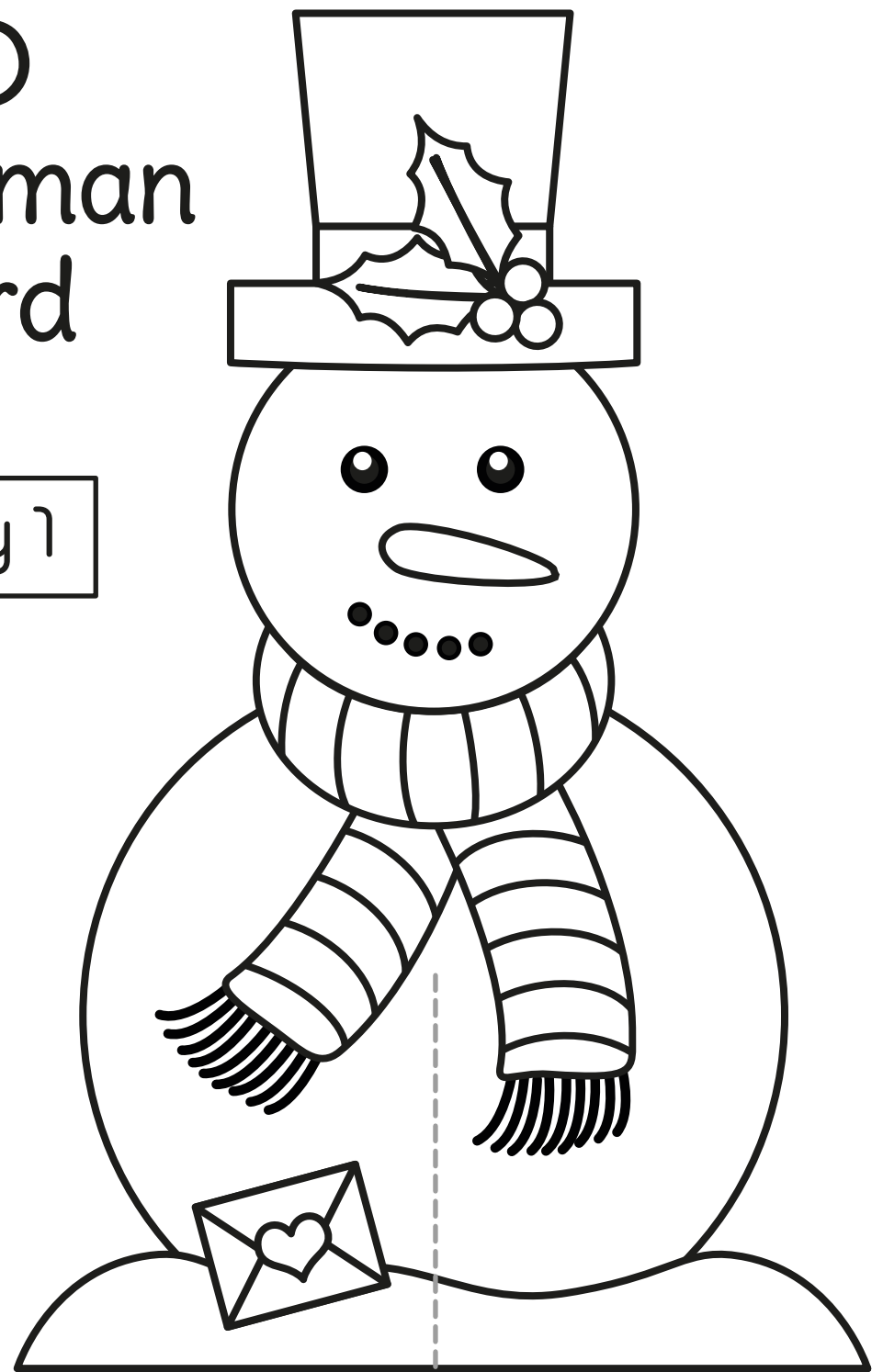
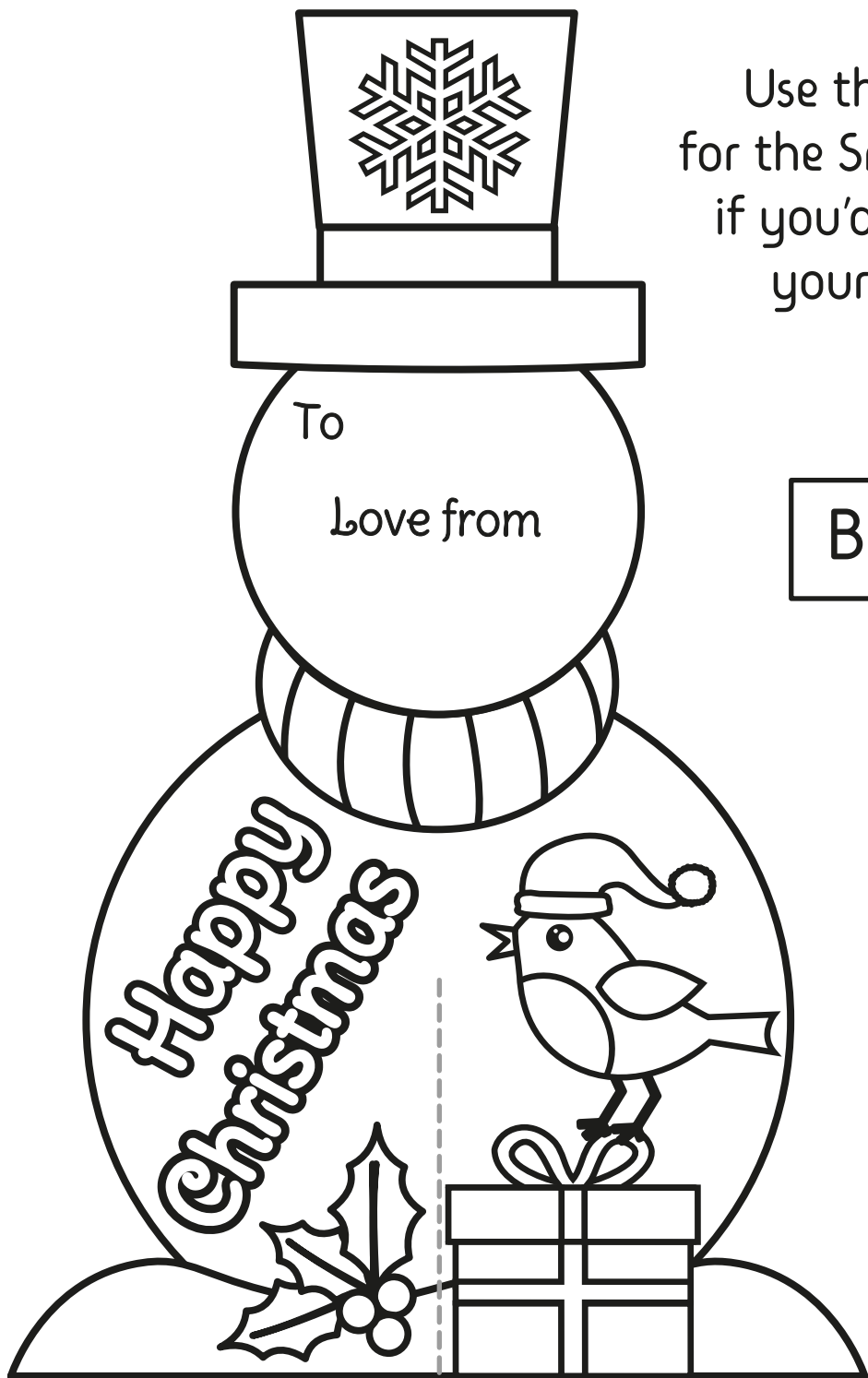


3D Snowman Card



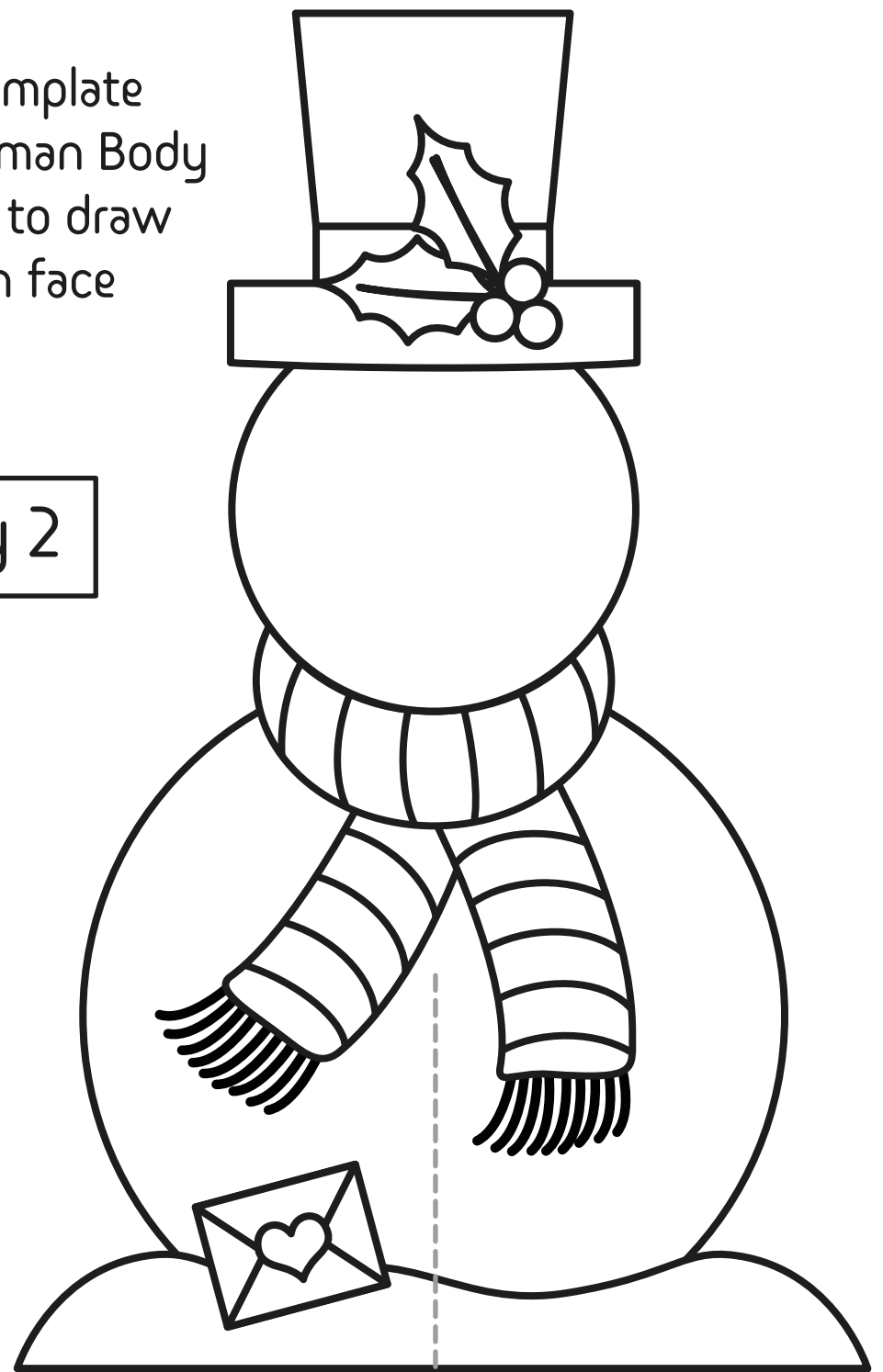

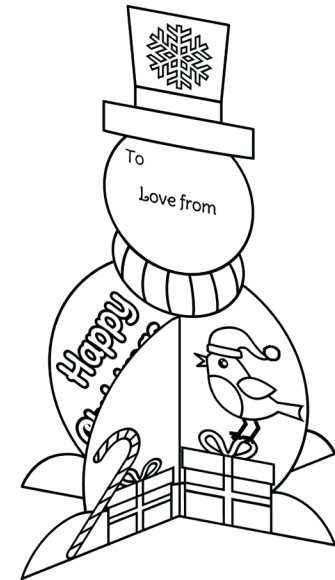
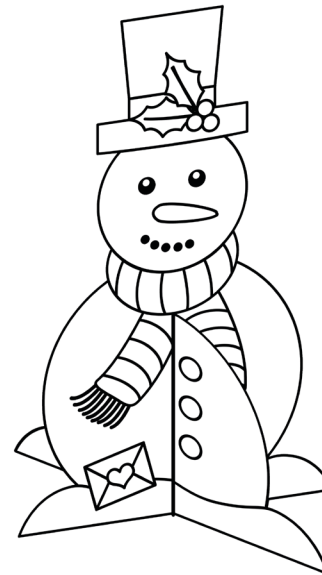


Stand



Instructions

1. Print onto thick paper/card. Choose between having the snowman's face pre-printed (Body 1) or blank to draw your own face (Body 2)

5. Use the blank template to make your own snowman designs.

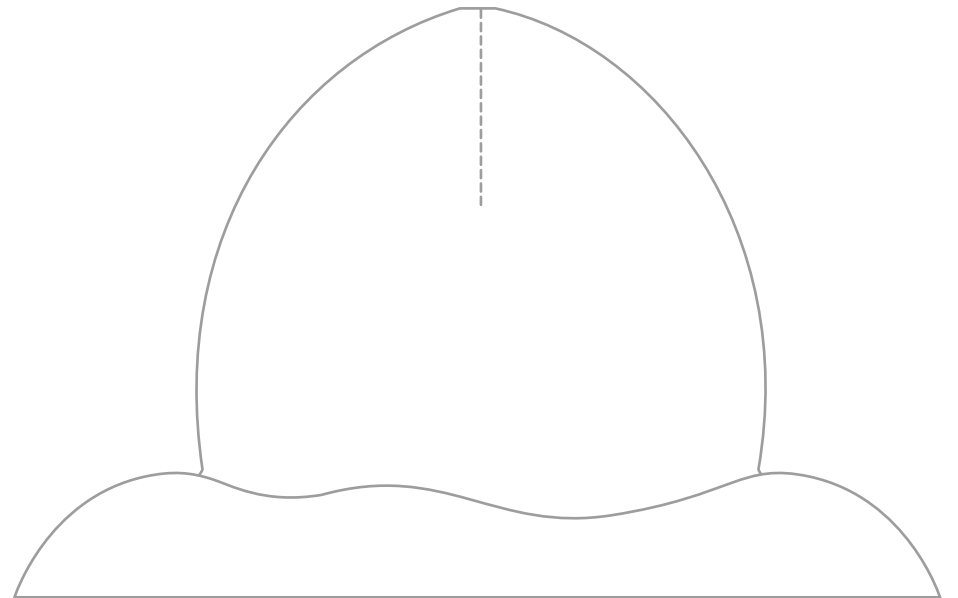
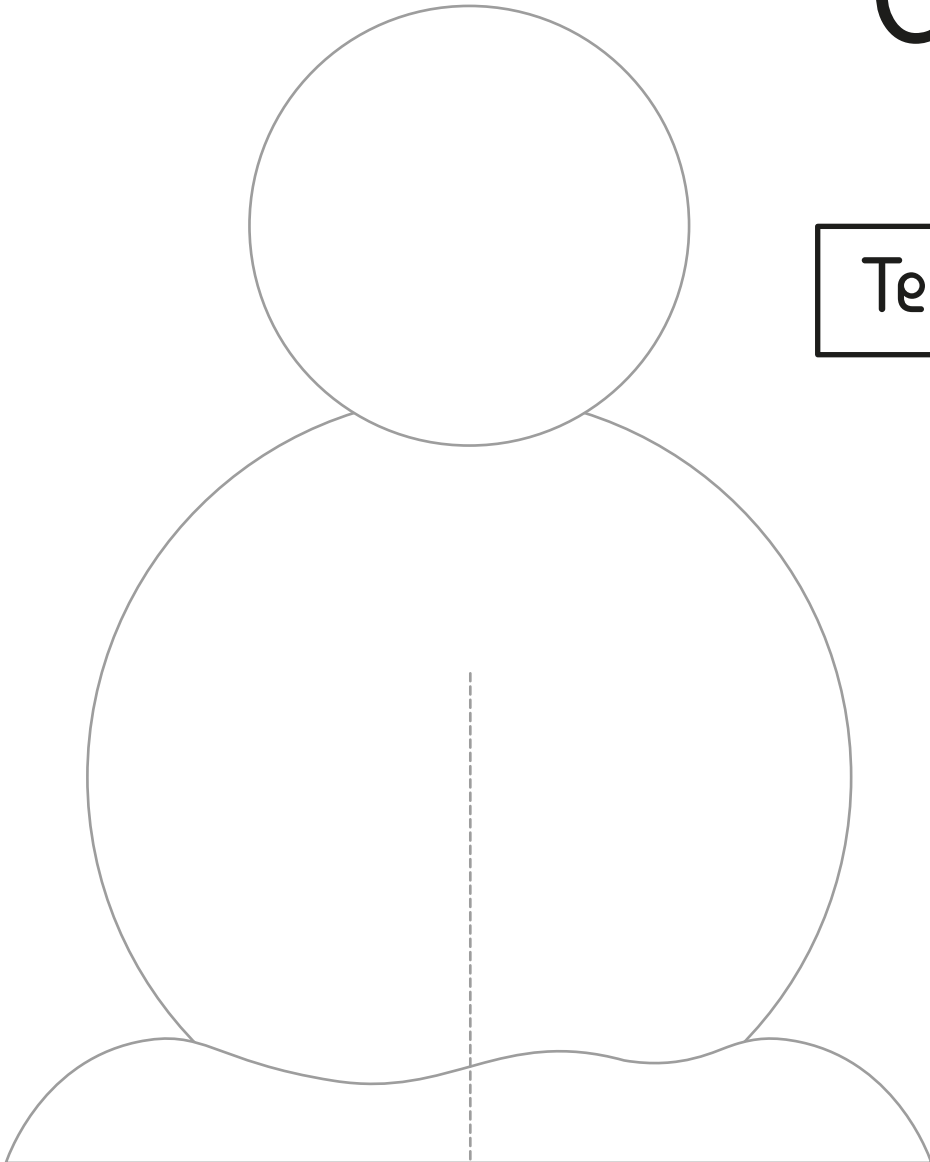

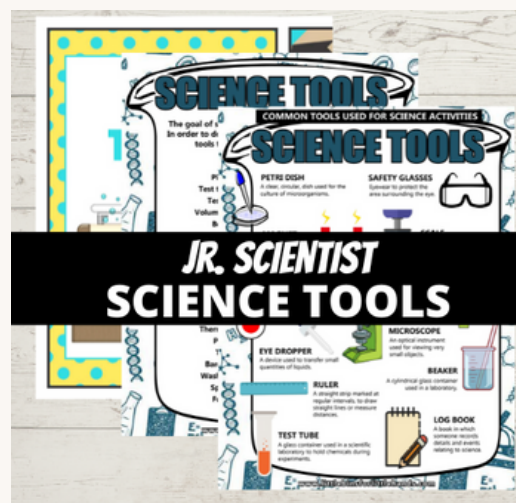
