INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1: Design your background with watercolor on canvas.

STEP 2: Once dry, use your decorative tape to create a bridge over the water.

STEP 3: Using scissors, cut your 'water lilies' out of the baking cups.

STEP 4: Use glue stick to add your lilies to your canvas.
