WHAT IS BINARY CODE?

Binary code is the language of computers, composed of only two digits: 0 and 1. Each digit is called a "bit," and they form the building blocks of information in the digital world. Through a series of combinations, these bits create strings of code that represent different characters, numbers, and commands. This system works on the principle of "on" and "off," where 0 represents "off" and 1 represents "on." It's the backbone of how computers process and store data, allowing them to perform complex tasks and execute instructions with remarkable precision.
